5	PROCEDURES OF SELECTION	5.25.35.45.5	 selected from Asia by qualification tournaments in Asia to participate i 2012 Olympic Table Tennis Competition. One (1) player from each regional zone (Central Asia, South Asia, Sou Asia and West Asia) will be selected from their respective regional zon qualification tournaments. Seven (7) other players will be selected from the General Zone Qualification tournament. Players not directly qualified from their regional zone tournament. While up to three (3) players from an NOC may qualify, any third (3rd) qualified from an NOC is only provisionally qualified until the team ma is known. If, after the Continental team quota has been determined, the more than 9 NOCs with three (3) players provisionally qualified, then of third (3rd) players from the top nine (9) teams will qualify. 		

6. ENTRIES & ACCREDITATION

- 6.1 Each Association is entitled to enter up to a maximum of three (3) men and three (3) women players, depending on the number of direct entries each Association has already qualified under the ITTF World Ranking List published following the 2011 World Championships and those qualified by the Asian regional zone qualifications.
- 6.2 If one (1) player from an Association is already qualified under direct entry by the ITTF World Ranking List or through the Asian Regional Zone Qualification Tournaments, only two (2) players from that Association may enter the Asian General Zone Qualification Tournament. Similarly, if two (2) players from an Association are already qualified under direct and the UTTE World Parking List and the under direct and the under direct.

entry by the ITTF World Ranking List and through the Asian Regional Zone Qualification Tournaments, only one (1) player from the Association may take part in the General Zone Qualification Tournament. All regional qualification tournaments will be completed by 5th February 2012.

- 6.3 The entry form must be returned to the Hong Kong Table Tennis Association no later than 20th February 2012 (Monday). The Organizer must be advised of any changes / substitutions no later than 7th April 2012 (Saturday), after this deadline no substitution or change of player is allowed.

7. SYSTEM OF PLAY

Both the Men's and Women's competitions will be played in 2 Stages:

7.1 <u>Stage I</u>

Depending on the numbers of entries in each event, the players will be divided into groups to play in a round robin system. Seeding of players will be based on the latest ITTF World Ranking List.

7.2 <u>Stage II</u>

Based on the results of Stage I competitions, players in top positions from each group shall play in a progressive knock-out system to determine the final position of the competition.

- 7.3 Players ranked higher than the 28th players directly qualified based on the ITTF Ranking List published following the 2011 World Championships need not compete in Stage I and will play directly in Stage II of the competition.
- 7.4 Appendix A provides an extract of the ITTF Ranking List, players with * marked against their names, if entered, will play directly in Stage II of the competition
- 7.5 System of play is outlined in Appendix B.
- 7.6 All matches shall be played in best of seven (7) games.

8. CONDUCT OF DRAWS

- 8.1 Draw for Stage I is scheduled in the afternoon of 18th April 2012 (Wednesday).
 - 8.2 Players of the same Association will be separated in different groups during Stage I.
 - 8.3 Draw for Stage II shall be conducted soon after Stage I is completed.
 - 8.4 The exact principle of draw is described in Appendix B.

9. RULES / ONDITIONS 9.1 The tournament will be conducted in accordance with the current Laws of Table Tennis and Regulations for International Competitions of the ITTF. 9.2 Eleveration and the attended to accordance with the current Laws of the ITTF.

- 9.2 Players must be attended to any interviews, promotional activities or functions relating to the tournament if required by the HKTTA.
- **10. RACKET CONTROL** All racket coverings must be a type currently authorized by ITTF. Racket Control will be carried out during the tournament.

Appendix B

2012 Asian Olympic Table Tennis Qualification Tournament

SYSTEM OF PLAY

Players ranked higher than the 28th players directly qualified based on the May 2011 ITTF Ranking List need not compete in Stage I of the competition and will play directly in Stage II. These players are marked with * against their names in Appendix A.

Stage I

Depending on the number of entries, the players will be drawn into groups 3 or 4 or 5 players on the basis of their ranking position on the latest World Ranking List prior to the event.

Depending on the number of groups in the first stage, players finishing in top positions in their groups will qualify for the second stage.

As an example, if 16 players enter the men's event, with 2 players directly qualified for Stage II, the remaining 14 players will be drawn into 4 groups of 3 or 4 players each. Players finishing 1st, 2nd and 3rd in groups with 4 players together with players finishing 1st and 2nd in groups of 3 players will qualify for Stage II.

Stage II

Together with players directly qualified for Stage II without having to play in Stage I, up to twelve (12) players will qualify for the second stage of the tournament.

An example of the system of play for Stage II is given in Annex I, when 16 players enter the men's event with 2 players directly qualified for Stage II. When more or fewer players enter, the number of groups will be modified accordingly.

CONDUCTING THE DRAW


Draw for Stage I will be conducted so that the highest ranked player will be placed in position 1 of Group A, the second highest player in position 1 of Group B. The third and fourth highest ranked players will be drawn into positions 1 of Group C or group D, etc.

After one entry has been placed in each group, the others shall be drawn by a modified snake system, ensuring that players from the same Association are drawn into different groups.

For the draw of Stage II, players of the same Association will be separated as far as possible and drawn into different halves or different quarters, but players having played against each other in previous draws will be separated if possible as a higher priority.


