EVENTS: Team, doubles and singles events for girls and boys 3. ELIGIBILITY: The World Junior Table Tennis Championships 2008 are open to athletes satisfying the following three conditions: a) being born in 1990 or later b) being eligible to represent their national association according to the rules 3.8, 4.1.3 and 4.4.3 of the ITTF Handbook 2008-2009. Note: the regulations have changed as and from 1st September 2008. c) selected (by team participation) or qualified for individuals according to this prospectus. For 2008, all players' passports must be submitted (scanned or faxed) together with the entry forms to ensure their eligibility. Any player whose passport has not been submitted will be considered as NOT ENTERED.

9. HOSPITALITY:

Hospitality will be provided by the Local Organizing Committee to all entitled to free hospitality from dinner on the 5 December to breakfast on the 14 December 2008.

- An association qualifying with <u>a team</u>, comprising four (4) athletes & one (1) coach, is entitled to free hospitality for a maximum of three (3) persons (double occupancy basis). If less than four (4) athletes are nominated the association is entitled to free hospitality for two (2) persons only.
- An association qualifying with <u>two teams</u> comprising eight (8) athletes & two (2) coaches, is entitled to free hospitality for a maximum of five (5) persons (double occupancy basis). If less than eight (8) athletes are entering the association is entitled to free hospitality for four (4) persons only.
- Athletes qualified to participate in the <u>Individual events only</u>: No free hospitality.

Rates for extra persons and those not entitled to free hospitality:

The Organizing Committee will charge a daily rate of: EURO € 80 per person in double occupancy and EURO € 120 per person in single occupancy including breakfast, lunch, dinner, accreditation and local transport. The rates will be available for a fixed number of extra persons on the "List of Official Party" as described in the point 10 "PARTICIPATION QUOTAS" and in the Entry Form.

Additional persons to those allowed below should contact the Organizing Committee for the "accompanying person's package" and deal directly with them for these packages. (accommodation rates for "Official Party" are subsidised by the Local Organizing Committee).

10. PARTICIPATION QUOTAS:

Team Events

16 teams will enter the boys and girls competition with a maximum of 4 players per team. Continental quotas:

Africa:	2 Boys' Teams	2 Girls' Teams
Asia:	4 Boys' Teams	4 Girls' Teams
Europe:	4 Boys' Teams	4 Girls' Teams
Latin America:	2 Boys' Teams	2 Girls' Teams
North America:	1 Boys' Team	1 Girls' Team
Oceania:	1 Boys' Team	1 Girls' Team

In addition to these 14 teams, the Host Association (Spain) is entitled to one team in each of the boys and girls team events; and the 16th participant in both boys and girls events team is decided by the ITTF World Junior Team Ranking List as at 1st September 2008.

Individual Events

Boys' and Girls' Singles

Up to 96 boys and 96 girls may enter the singles with a maximum of 4 boys and 4 girls per association and with the exception of the Host Association (Spain) which is entitled to enter up to six boys and six girls.

The positions for the SINGLES events will be distributed as follows:

- ITTF U18 World Junior Individual Ranking (1st September) 30

TOTAL:

A total of thirty athletes (15 JB and 15 JG) are selected based on their position on the 1 September ITTF U 18 ranking lists.

An association earning one ranking selection may enter one additional athlete to participate ONLY in the individual events (singles and doubles paired with the earned ranking selection).







An association earning two ranking selections may enter two additional athletes to fill the maximum quota of four entries competing ONLY in the individual events (singles and doubles paired each of them with one of the earned ranking selections).

Boys' and Girls' Doubles

Up to 48 pairs of boys and girls may enter the World Championships with a maximum of 2 boys' pairs and 2 girls' pairs per Association and with the exception of the Host Association (Spain), which is entitled to enter up to 3 boys' pairs and 3 girls' pairs. These 48 pairs will be composed from the players entered for the teams and singles events.

In boys and girls doubles events both players of a pair shall be from the same association.

Each Association may enter a maximum of 4 players (if entitled by team selection or ranking selection in singles) but it is not permitted to enter different players in the team event and in the individual events.

Mixed Doubles

Up to 96 mixed pairs may enter the mixed doubles. They will be selected out of the players entered for the teams and singles events.

Associations may form a mixed double pair consisting of players from different Associations.

Coaches/Officials/Accompanying persons

According to the ITTF policy starting with the WJTTC Palo Alto 2007 last year, the number of persons that can join the teams in the "Official Party" is limited as follows:

For an Association with two teams participating, the maximum is:

- ➢ 8 Athletes (4 boys and 4 girls)
- Two coaches
- One Medical Staff
- Two delegates

For Associations with one or no team participating and from 5 to 8 players in total participating in the individual events, the maximum is:

- > 8 Athletes (4 boys and 4 girls up to the limit of qualified/selected players)
- Two coaches
- One Medical Staff
- One delegate







For Associations with 1 to 4 players participating, the maximum is:

- > 4 Athletes (up to the limit of qualified/selected players)
- > One coach for each three players participating (maximum two coaches)
- One Medical Staff
- > One delegate

11. ENTRIES:

Note that following the decision of the ITTF AGM in February, all players participating at the World Junior Championships in Madrid must provide proof of their eligibility to compete in this World Title Event; and it is the responsibility of the National Association to provide such a document to the ITTF. <u>At the time of the entry all the players' passports have to be submitted (scanned or fax copy) and failing to do so will result in non-acceptance of the entry.</u>

The deadline for confirmation of participation for the team events is October 15th 2008.

The deadline of Final Entries for the individual events (and nominal entries for those entered in teams) is October 25th 2008.

Associations are requested to confirm their participation as soon as possible. Preferably final entries should be submitted by electronic methods (e-mail).

In order to secure full participation, national associations failing to confirm their participation according to deadlines will be removed from the list of participants and replaced by another association. Please be especially aware of that the Association of a selected team must confirm before 15th October 2008 their participation.

If a confirmed team fails to arrive in Madrid, it will be replaced by the highest ranked team composed of players already entered in the individual events.

12. OBLIGATIONS:

The entry forms will contain a statement that the players nominated are willing to compete against any other participating player. This statement must be signed by a responsible official of the nominating Association and no entry form will be accepted unless such an undertaking has been given.







13. TELEVISION, MOTION PICTURE AND INTERNET COVERAGE CONDITIONS:

By entering the Championships, participants agree to abide by all ITTF rules and by the rules and regulations of the Organizing Committee. All entered associations, teams and individual players agree to be under the auspices of the ITTF and its agents in all matters concerning television coverage, video, internet web casting, motion picture coverage, and photographic coverage of any kind. Participants release all rights, or rights held by their agents or sponsors, in all matters relating to television and web casting coverage, video and motion picture coverage, and photographic coverage of any kind; and hence accept such coverage during the World Championships. A participant's refusal of above listed coverage may be subject to suspension or dismissal from the competition. Any participant, when called upon, must appear promptly to press conferences or medal presentations and follow the procedures set by the ITTF and the Organizing Committee.

14. ENTRY FEES:

According to the ITTF Handbook, 4.4.4.1:

The entry fees shall be 34 EURO (50 USD) for each entry in a team event, 20 EURO (30 USD) for each pair in a doubles event and 10 EURO (15 USD) for each entry in a singles event.

These entry fees have to be submitted together with the accommodation fees to VIAJES EL CORTE INGLES (see details below).

15. PAYMENTS:

Associations are requested to pay their entry fees, extra hospitality costs and hospitality costs for those persons not entitled to free accommodation and meals, when submitting their entry forms and upon reception of the pro-forma invoice from the Organizing Committee. PLEASE DO NOT MAKE ANY BANK TRANSFER BEFORE RECEIVING THE PRO-FORMA INVOICE.

The Organizing Committee will make hotel reservations and pick-up bus arrangements only for Associations that have completed their payments.

Cancellation Policy

Cancellation policy will be announced in due time together with other information, but no later than 25th October.

16. SYSTEM OF PLAY:

TEAM EVENTS

The first stage will be played in a round robin basis (groups of four teams) with the winner and runner-up in each group advancing to play for the positions 1st to 8th and the third and fourth placed teams in each group advancing to play for the positions 9th to 16th.

The second stage will be played in a progressive knock-out basis, playing for all the positions with the exception of the match for the positions 3rd and 4th. The two loosing teams in the semifinals will be awarded the third position and bronze medals.

Teams seeded 1-4 will be placed in group A to D following the order of ranking. Seed 1 goes to Group A, Seed two to group B, Seed three to group C and Seed four to group D.

Teams seeded 5-8 will be drawn to position 2 in group A to D using the modified snake system two by two: teams seeded 5th and 6th will be draw among the groups C & D. Teams seeded 7th and 8th will be draw among the groups A & B.

Teams seeded 9-12 will be drawn to position 3 in group A to D using the modified snake system two by two: Teams seeded 9th and 10th will be drawn among the groups A & B. Teams seeded 11th and 12th will be draw among the groups C & D.

Teams seeded 13-16 will be drawn to position 4 in group A to D using the same criteria (13th and 14th in the groups C & D and 15th and 16th in the groups A & B).

Matches will be played in Best of 5 singles matches (A v X, B v Y, C v Z, A v Y & B v X) All matches in the team events to the best of five games.

INDIVIDUAL EVENTS

Boys' and Girls' Singles

The first stage will be played in a round robin basis (groups of 4 player's basis with some groups of 3 players if the number of entries does not reach the maximum of 96); two players advance from each group to the second stage. Matches in the first stage will be played to the best of 5 games.

The second stage will be a main draw of 64 with a maximum of 48 players competing on knock-out basis. All matches will be best of 7 games.







Boys' Doubles, Girls' Doubles and Mixed Doubles

The event will be played on a knock-out basis throughout. Matches bet of five games with the exception that Quarter-Finals, Semi-Finals and Finals will be best of seven games.

REMINDER:

The above selected athletes are qualified to enter the individual events (singles and doubles). In addition each association with one qualified athlete may enter one additional athlete to form at least one double pair (paired with the qualified athlete). An association with two qualified athletes has the right to enter two additional athletes to fill the maximum quota of four athletes competing in singles and doubles (also paired with the qualified athletes). Not more than 4 players are entitled to participate from the same Association.

Note that the selection will be made in order of ranking, but if by the deadline of 15th October a player from the SELECTED list has not confirmed their intention of participation (or has not confirmed a doubles partner) **that player will lose the right to participate** (or the right to nominate a doubles partner) and the ITTF will contact the next player on the reserve list.

18. SEEDING:

Seeding for all the events will be done according to the last available ITTF U18 Team and Individual rankings at the time of the draws. Seeding for the doubles will be done according to the addition of the points of the players in the last available ranking and with the possible input of the ITTF Ranking Committee for some pairs.

20. DRAWS:

For the <u>Team Events</u> will be performed on December 5th at 15:00 hours in the same place connected to the Delegates' Meeting.

For the Singles (First Stage) and Doubles Events the draws will be performed on 7th December at a time to be specified in the Sport Specific Document in November.







21. VISAS:

If you need a visa to enter Spain, and in order to succeed and avoid any problems, please follow these steps:

- 1. Read carefully the attached document "VISA INFORMATION PROCEDURES"
- 2. Fill all the fields included in the VISA FORM for those persons requiring VISA.
- 3. Submit your entry form **FILLED WITH ALL THE REQUIRED DETAILS** and establish contact with Ms. Carmen Abad **cabad@madrid16.es** with a copy to Raul Calin: **rcalin@ittf.com** "now" in order to expedite your visa application.
- 4. Please understand the special and strict regulations for the VISAS applications for Spain/European Community for certain countries and do not delay unnecessarily the process, this may result in not obtaining in time your VISA for the Championships. Note that requirements for the VISAS are not under the jurisdiction of the ITTF but under the Spanish Government jurisdiction and you must fulfill such requirements in order to get your VISA.
